EVERY CHILD A SUPER READER

This year our students will build on the seven strengths of being a SUPER READER. Between September 10 and October 12 we will focus on:

Belonging

What you can do to promote belonging at home through reading:

Book Baskets - Create personalized book baskets for each family member that reflect their interests

Heart Maps - Have each family member draw a heart on a sheet of paper and fill it in with words and images that represent where he or she has felt a sense of belonging

Belonging Bulletin - Create a bulletin board or area on the refrigerator for each family member to share his or her passions and interests

Family Interviews - Have your child interview family members about groups and communities to which they belong including questions like:

- Who is your best friend and why?
- What is your favorite thing to do?
- What was your favorite thing to do when you were my age?
- What group has felt important to you in your life?

Family Favorites Book - As a family, compile a list of your favorite things to do together:

- Favorite book to read aloud
- Favorite song
- Favorite memories
