- 6. Providing timely information concerning the Title I program inclusive of planning, implementation, and evaluation.
- 7. Soliciting parents' suggestions in the planning, development, and operation of the program.
- 8. Providing timely responses to parents' recommendations.
- 9. Facilitating participation by parents in school activities.
- 10. Notifying all parents in the Union County Public Schools' District of the Annual Parent Engagement (Public Hearing) meeting.
- 11. Providing system and school report cards to document academic performance on a yearly basis, to include the Annual Report to the People of Union County.
- 12. Evaluating annual the process of parent/community engagement to specifically look at barriers, level of involvement, and strategies to increase engagement of all populations.
- 13. Provide advertisement for opportunities for parents to be involved in their child's education.
