


UCPS Schools will be closed from April 15-April 24. School resumes on April 25th.







Scholarship Information

<u>*NEW* <mark>Agnes Liles Scholarship</mark></u>

Every four years six UCPS seniors receive the Agnes Liles scholarship. This award provides \$7,500 per student per year of higher education. (Total award per student = \$30,000) Agnes Liles was a hairdresser and her husband was a UCPS bus driver. They never had any children and were very frugal. In their will, Mr. and Ms. Liles directed their trustees to assist in costs of higher education for worthy students. In addition to need, the scholarship committee considers character, demonstration of a desire to improve the general condition, and willingness to work. Students interested should pick up an application from Ms. Lawson and do the following -

- An essay of 250-500 words that describes the student's character, demonstration of a desire to improve the general condition, and willingness to work.
- A letter of acceptance from the college he/she will be attending.
- One teacher recommendation submitted directly to Chris Conway (christopher.conway@ucps.k12.nc.us).
- Most recent high school transcript.

Students should submit completed applications to Chris Conway via email (christopher.conway@ucps.k12.nc.us). The deadline to submit applications is 5:00pm on May 12, 2022. Only complete application packets will be considered.

Gamma Delta Chapter Scholarship

The purpose of the Gamma Delta Chapter Scholarship is to support and foster the educational pursuits of deserving high school seniors in Union County Schools who plan to attend a four-year college, university, community college, or technical school. The amount of the scholarship is \$750. Scholarship eligibility requirements are listed below -

- High School Senior
- GPA 2.5 or higher
- Applied and been accepted to college, university, community college, or technical school
- Demonstrate leadership abilities in school, participated in volunteer community service, extracurricular activities, and other activities

A completed application must be submitted by April 22nd, 2022. You will need an official transcript, three letters of recommendation (two must be from a teacher, counselor or principal who are not related to you), Community Service Documentation - must provide verification of volunteer community service. In addition, you must write an essay. The essay should be completed in 12 point font, double spaced. Please address in 400 words or less why this scholarship is important to you, what your future career goals are, and how you plan to contribute to society. Please see Ms. Lawson for the application.

Louisiana Robinson Education & Leadership Scholarship (NAACP Scholarship)

Students applying for this scholarship should be interested in pursuing higher education. You will need to submit the following materials by <u>April 24th, 2022</u>

- Official Transcript in sealed envelope
- Typed cover letter showing community service through the NAACP signed by the Youth Director in addition to service activities performed through school activities
- Three letters of recommendation, each including the name and phone number of the contact person for verification purposes (may be submitted by letterhead). One letter should be in regard to community service. The other letters of recommendation should be from an employer or school official.
- Essay
- Participate in interview conducted by the NAACP Scholarship Committee (TBD)

Union County Extension Master Gardener Volunteer Association Scholarship

The Union County Extension Master Gardener Scholarship is in the amount of \$1000. The applicant must be a resident of Union County. The applicant must be a graduating senior attending school (public, charter, home, etc) in Union County, in good standing, with at least 3.0 GPA. The applicant must be planning to attend a college or university and be majoring in botany, environmental studies, forestry, landscape architecture, horticulture, crop sciences, local foods, animal husbandry or related fields. This award will be based on academic standing, student personal statement and one teacher/counselor (or other non-family member) recommendation. Student statement should explain why the student deserves this scholarship, educational goals and what they plan to do with their degree. The statement can be less than 1 but no more than 2 pages in length. Teacher/counselor recommendations should include why the student is qualified for this scholarship. Paper recommendation should be submitted with the scholarship application in a sealed envelope by the application deadline. Emailed recommendation may be sent separately to the listed address by the deadline. **The deadline to apply is May 1st, 2022.** If you're interested in applying to this scholarship please see Ms. Lawson for the application.
