





In the event of severe weather, rain dates have been set to reschedule ceremonies. Principals will communicate directly to seniors and their families, if the date of their graduation is changed.


UCPS will follow the latest health and safety guidelines from the North Carolina Health and Human Services











Weekly Athletic Calendar

- ITT Centennial Scholarship
 - Awarded to the top Centennial
 - \$22,000 / year for 4 years and \$7,500 in enrichment funds
- Kimbrell Centennial Scholarship
 - Awarded to the 2nd top Centennial
 - \$20,000 / year for 4 years and \$7,500 in enrichment funds
- Centennial Scholarship
 - \$15,000 / year for 4 years and \$7,500 in enrichment funds
 - O Up to 8 awarded per year
- Pioneer Scholarship
 - \$14,000 / year for four years and \$4,000 in enrichment funds
 - O Up to 4 awarded per year
- North Carolina Textile Foundation Scholarship
 - \$5,000 / year for 4 years
- Prestige Scholarship
