Students complete an application and our school scholarship committee, consisting of school counselors, an administrator and teachers, reviews the applications of students and chooses our school nominee(s). The student(s) selected as our school nominee then applies directly to the institution for the larger competition.

These deadlines are final. No exception. Some of the scholarships allow students to self-nominate if they are not chosen as their school's nominee. 




