PRHS Families - The following information was sent out to PRHS families, along with all UCPS MS and HS families. We have provided that message below, along with some additional information from Porter Ridge High School. This information has also been sent via email, phone call, and all social media.

### **UCPS Parent Message 10/28:**

Dear middle and high school parents,

Union County Public School is providing a very important update about instructional models. In an effort to plan for second semester classes, teaching schedules and more, UCPS is launching a Virtual Academy Application for middle and high school students.

If your child will <u>remain in or transition to the Virtual Academy (Plan D)</u> for the second semester, you must complete the 6-12 Virtual Academy application via Scribbles. The application period will open Friday, Oct. 30 and close Sunday, Nov. 8 at 11:59 p.m.

If your child will remain in or transition to Plan B for in-person learning at school, two days a week, there is no action for your family.

Under Plan B, students are expected to attend school (in person) on their assigned day. Students who do not attend school will be marked absent.

Additional Information from Porter Ridge High School:

### **Choosing a Plan:**

Families have until 11/8 to apply to make their decision, once families have made their decisions about which plan to choose, PRHS Administrators will work with our master schedule to best meet the overall needs of our students. Please understand that there may be schedule changes based on this information and that we will provide updated second semester schedules prior to the start of second semester. We will not know in advance what courses will be offered through the Virtual Academy (Plan D). Our focus will be on providing access to graduation requirements in the Virtual Academy. Plan D will have a component of live instruction on a daily basis, so students will need to be accessing the course at the scheduled time of the class. Students must have reliable access to the internet to participate in Virtual Academy.

### **Attendance Expectations:**

Students choosing Plan B for Second Semester: Under Plan B during Second Semester, students are expected to attend school (in person) on their assigned day. Students who do not attend school will be marked absent. We understand that there will be certain reasons, with appropriate documentation, that can allow for Students to temporarily be remote on their assigned days. When these situations arise, please contact your student's counselor or assistant principal for direction. If the district moves to Plan A during the second semester, students in Plan B will move to Plan A and will be expected to be in the building each day for school.

Students choosing Plan D - Virtual Academy at PRHS: Students not intending to attend school in person during the second semester should choose Plan D - Virtual Academy. Plan D will have a component of live instruction on a daily basis, so students will need to be accessing the course at the scheduled time of the class. Remember that if you choose to stay in or move to Plan D - you MUST follow the link above to complete the application by 11/8/20.
