



Reminders about Grades and Attendance:

- Students participating in Plan B (face to face/hybrid) are expected to be online in their virtual class meeting Monday through Thursday and are expected to complete all assigned work from these classes by the due date. Additionally, these students have remote learning on Fridays with additional assignments that are due. If a student is not participating and/or not submitting assignments, they will receive no credit for that assignment. This can result in a student failing. Teachers have office hours available Fridays if your student needs to meet for extra help or questions.
- Students who are in our Plan D, or PR Virtual Academy, may be taking both traditional virtual courses and the Plan B (face to face/hybrid) classes. Students in Plan D are also expected to complete all assigned work from these classes by the due dates. If a Plan D student is in a Plan B (face to face/hybrid) class they must attend the virtual meetings during the class time.
- We do realize that there may be intermittent problems with a student's internet or access, however, the student is expected to be communicating that, with screenshots, to the teacher at the time of the problem. We hope you understand how important this is.
- We want all of our students to be successful!! You are welcome to contact their teachers, their counselors, or their administrator to see how your student can get on track.

Spring 2020 Grade Correction Request

Students who passed a class in spring 2020 had a choice of either the numerical grade or PC19. Students who did not make a choice in the spring and want to change what they received may do so up until October 16, 2020. If you choose numeric average, you are choosing the higher of T4 or T4/T5 average as your final grade and it will count in your GPA. If you choose the PC19 the grade will not count in your GPA calculation. Please note the final day to process this form is Friday, October 16, 2020 at 8:00am.
