








#### Spring 2020 Grade Correction Request

Students who were in Grades 9-11 in 2019-20 who passed a class in spring 2020 had a choice of either the numerical grade or PC19. Students who did not make a choice in the spring and want to change what they received may do so up until October 16, 2020. If you choose numeric average, you are choosing the higher of T4 or T4/T5 average as your final grade and it will count in your GPA. If you choose the PC19 the grade will not count in your GPA calculation. Please note the final day to process this form is Friday, October 16, 2020 at 8:00am.

### **Career of the Week**

#### "Career of the Week – Arbitrators, Mediators, & Conciliators"

Arbitrators, Mediators, & Conciliators facilitate negotiation and conflict resolution through dialogue. They resolve conflicts outside of the court system by mutual consent of parties involved. Arbitrators, Mediators, & Conciliators use mediation techniques to facilitate communication between disputants, to further parties' toward mutual agreement. They interview claimants, agents, or witnesses to obtain information about disputed issues, apply relevant laws, regulations, policies, or precedents to reach conclusions. To become an Arbitrator, Mediator, or Conciliator, one must have a Bachelor's degree. The average salary for the state of North Carolina is \$65,020 and is expected to experience strong job growth over the next decade.
