Dear Pirate Community,

Thank you to the many parents who came out to meet our teachers and staff on Tuesday September 3rd. Parents got to put faces to names, ask questions about syllabi and content, and see the classrooms where their children learn! Senior parents and seniors were able to attend the Senior College Info Night on the same night to get information on the college application timeline and process.

Safety and security is a priority here at PRHS. Every day we work on monitoring the campus and support our students in the proper safety procedures. Our school has completed two fire drills so that students are familiar with proper exiting from the school. We will continue with other safety drills in the near future. This week Administration, our staff, and our School Resource Officer, Officer Humphrey, held Safety and Security Assemblies with our students. Topics discussed included the importance of reporting any safety concerns to the SRO and Administration, behavior expectations at school and on campus, bus behavior expectations, proper use of social media, the role of the School Resource Officer, and safety procedures in the classroom and hallways. Students were encouraged to create a culture of respect here at Porter Ridge High School. Our students were very receptive and we are proud of how respectful they have been. There is a definite culture of respect here at the school - one that respects the safety of others and one that respects the goal of our school - learning and growing together.

Our student body will have access to a club fair on Thursday and Friday 9/12-13. Please talk to your child about the importance of being involved in school or in a community based activity. This not only promotes a sense of community, but it develops life and social skills that our students need for the future!

Our Pirate Advisory started this week with 9th graders completing a transition survey that will help us identify needs, 11th graders working on plans for post-high school, and 12th graders finalizing their resume. Our 10th graders will work on a career survey next week during advisory to identify possible career area interests! If you have not asked your child to show you their Naviance Student account, we hope that you will do so. There are great resources for every child in our school, ones that we think you will also enjoy researching.

Please take time to read over this newsletter. These newsletters are sent on a weekly basis so that the whole community can read about the great things our children and teachers are doing. The Pirate Press, in addition to our website, will be the main form of communication from school to home.



The Graphic Design Club will have its first interest meeting on Wednesday, Sept.11th after school in Room E105C. See Mrs. Gordon if you have questions.


HOSA will have its first meeting September 17th at 7:30am in E212. If you are interested in the medical field this is the club for you!
