





LEADERSHIP AT PORTER RIDGE HIGH

Porter Ridge High School is a Leadership High School where we work to make sure students can Lead Themselves first, and then lead others next.

SCHOOL/FAMILY COMMUNICATION

PRHS uses a weekly newsletter to keep parents informed of what goes on at school – the **Pirate Press**. It is emailed to the main email address we have on file. Beginning of School Year Information

CELL PHONES are permitted for student use in between classes and during lunch. However, cell phones must be silenced and put AWAY during all class periods. This is to enhance the learning environment for all students. We have specific behavioral expectations for students to keep their cell phone with them during the day. Students may not use it to harass other students, to record other students or teachers without their knowledge, or to violate the PRHS or UCPS Code of Conduct in any way.

BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR FORMS: On Tuesday 8/29, all students will meet in Pirate Advisory (listed as "Homeroom" on their schedule). They will go to Pirate Advisory after first period and teachers will explain that to the students. In Advisory they will learn more about PRHS and will have a review of important rules and procedures. You can access the **Codes of Conduct here** so that you can review them as well. Students will bring home three paper forms on Tuesday 8/29, the rest of the forms needed are available online by clicking here: **online forms**

SUPPLY LISTS for students' classes will be on the syllabus for the class, however, supply lists may not be definite until the first day of school. To access the syllabus (after 8/26), go to the PRHS website, click on the 'I want to' button in the right hand side, click on staff directory, and find your teacher's name. There is a link to the classroom canvas page in this part of the directory.

VAPES/TOBACCO AND TOBACCO-LESS PRODUCTS — Vapes are an issue with teenagers everywhere today. Please help us keep our school a healthy environment for ALL students by having a direct conversation with your child that vapes are prohibited on school campus and if a student is found to have a vape we have strict consequences. We suggest that you have this conversation frequently and ask your child to clean out their book bag to make sure this will not be an issue.



Attend Today and Achieve Tomorrow

Student attendance at school is expected and is necessary for students to make the most of their learning. Please work with us as we try to teach our students that attendance is required, just as it would be at a job in their future.

- Parents can provide notes for up to five days that a student is absent. After those days PRHS will require a doctor/medical note to excuse the absence.
- An absence will be recorded as unexcused until the note is submitted. Parent notes must be in within five days of the student's return to school.
- If a student misses 8 or more days of school in a semester, whether the absences are excused or unexcused, the student will fail the course due to attendance.



Transportation Car Rider, Bus Rider, Student Driver

CAR-RIDER: If you are dropping your child off at school please expect slightly longer lines at car-rider drop-off during the first week of school. We strongly encourage you to arrive on campus by 7:45am to ensure your child is to class on time. This is a good guideline to follow all year long. Please follow all directions of staff as we utilize the whole front lane to drop students off in the morning. In the afternoon your student will walk to your car – most parents text their location in the line.

BUS-RIDER: Please sign up for the Edu-Log Parent Portal for bus transportation. Your child can get their Bus Boarding Pass through this app. You can get more information, along with how to download the app at the **UCPS Transportation website**. We will be able to assist you with this at Open House on 8/25 if you need help. **It is so IMPORTANT that your child is at their bus stop 20 minutes early each day.** We would suggest a little earlier the first two weeks of school. "Our bus driver shortage continues and will impact operations as we open school. We will continue to practice strategies put in place in prior years, including double runs and bus stop consolidation. In addition to the normal 1st week delays, we anticipate added challenges with the bus driver shortage. We will be communicating any delays using the Edulog Parent Portal app, and additional information is available on the UCPS Transportation website. Your patience and understanding is greatly appreciated as we work through these challenges."

STUDENT-DRIVERS: All student drivers MUST have a parking pass to enter the student lot. This means that they must purchase and pick up their parking pass before school starts. Parking passes are available for sale now and can be picked up on 8/25 during open house and at lunch the first day of school. Students should arrive to park by 7:45am. Students must come directly into the school on arrival – there is no loitering in the parking lot. More information about student parking is on the next page. Students will be emailed once their parking pass application is approved with a parking spot number starting August 21.

Students can **pick up the pass** on Thursday, August 24 from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM outside the stadium (JV Football Game) or Friday, August 25, from 12-3 at the Open House. **STUDENTS CANNOT PARK WITHOUT A PARKING PASS-COME PICK UP YOUR PARKING PASS.** Email losh.wall@ucps.k12.nc.us with questions.

The AP Capstone Program started with the Class of 2021 at Porter Ridge and our Capstone students have an excellent record of high performance in AP courses, with over 95% of our Class of 2023 earning a diploma or certificate. Students may take these courses along with other AP Courses and be eligible to work towards an AP Capstone Diploma from the College Board. According to College Board, AP Capstone is built on the foundation of two AP® courses — AP Seminar and AP Research — and is designed to complement and enhance the in-depth, discipline-specific study experienced in other AP courses. 




- The Schedule Correction Google Form will close on **Friday, September 1st at 5:00 pm.**
- **Requests for 1st & 2nd semester should be made at this time.** All corrections must be requested on the same submission. Only one request will be allowed.
- All schedules have been reviewed. We will not make changes for students who were
 placed in the 1st or alternative courses requested. Requests will only be considered for
 the following:
 - Senior is missing a required class for graduation or for college admissions
 - Student has not met or is missing a prerequisite for a course for which they are enrolled
 - Student is taking a course that he/she has passed
 - Student is missing a required core course (English, Math, Science, Social Studies) in their schedule
 - Student has the same course listed twice on the schedule
 - Student has "Please See your counselor" listed on their schedule. Please See
 Counselor is listed on your schedule if your counselor was not able to fill your schedule with courses you selected (including alternates).

Please make sure to fill out the form, so that your schedule is ready for the 1st day of school, which is Monday, August 28th. A counselor will email you as we are able to process your request at your UCPS school email whether a correction can or cannot be made to your schedule.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q. If a student is enrolled in the Pre-Apprentice or Traditional Pathway, do they have to transfer to Weddington High School or Porter Ridge High School?
- A. No, students will stay at their home school and travel to take the Teaching as a Profession courses at either Weddington High School or Porter Ridge High School. Please see your Career Development Coordinator for information about transportation.
- Q. Is there a fee for this program?
- A. Under Next Stop: TeachUCPS, tuition fees are covered. The program dees not fully cover additional fees
- Q. If a student is enrolled in the Pre-Apprentice or Traditional Pathway, can they still participate in the Career and College Promise program A. Yes, students have the opportunity to take community college courses through Career and College Promise while in the program
- Q. Will the CTE Teaching as a Profession Pathway be expanded to other high schools?
- A. This will be reviewed annually and program expansion will be based on student interest and available funding.
- Q. How can I learn more about TeachUCPS and apply?


