- Counselors will begin senior one-on-one meetings during the month of September to discuss post-secondary plans.
- Students should begin looking in Naviance for scholarship and college information. Individual colleges and universities will also have information regarding scholarships and application deadlines.
- The Blumenthal Performing Arts Junior Ambassador Program: The Junior Ambassador program is designed to give a select group of high school juniors and seniors a look inside the world of the performing arts industry. In this program, students have the opportunity to usher for many performances at BPA, including touring Broadway shows, symphonies, local theater companies, and so many other great performances. Students will also attend seminars to learn more about what goes on behind the scenes at a performing arts center. Other seminars include career planning and resume help.
