We overstocked our school nurse on goodies and provided 70 dozen baked goods and treats for the Teachers Holiday Cookie Exchange!







SECU Scholarship

This is a \$10,000 scholarship over four years. All eligible high school seniors must meet the following requirements

- Must be a senior in NC High School
- Must be a member of SECU or be eligible to become a member through parent/guardian
- Must be United States citizen, a resident of NC, and eligible for in-state tuition
- Must be accepted to attend one of the 16 UNC Systems Universities as a full-time student
- Must have at least an unweighted 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Must have demonstrated leadership, excellence of character, integrity and community service
- Must file FAFSA as part of the application
