Free Breakfast, Lunch, & Curbside Meals

- Due to extensions in federal funding, all students will be able to receive breakfast and lunch meals free of charge until December 31, 2020.
- For students attending in person classes, breakfast and lunch meals will be available free of charge to students each day. A la carte items will also be available for purchase at regular prices.
- For students learning virtually, lunch meals will be provided free of charge for curbside pickup between 11 am- 1 pm at select locations. A student lunch number is no longer required for curbside pickup. Meals are available for all kids under 18 years old, including children outside of UCPS.
