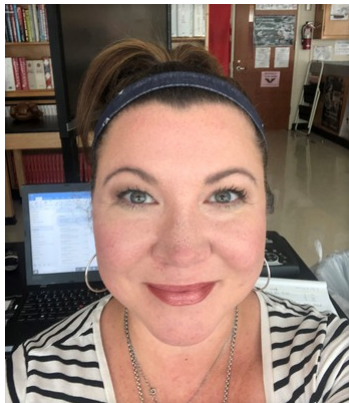

New to Monroe High School:



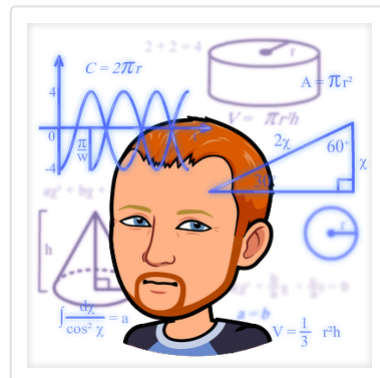
Jennifer Ritz- Culinary Teacher
