To view your schedule

- Log in to Power School (Go to PRHS, QuickLinks, then choose “PowerSchool Parent Portal”)
- On the left there are several tabs, choose “Grades & Attendance”.
- The schedule for the year for your child will appear.

Understanding your schedule

Plan B Students: Students that are scheduled at school one day per week and remote learning the other four days.

Example schedule:

T1,T2,T3 are the three grading periods that make up Semester1. This indicates that the course listed in this row is a Semester 1 course.

T4,T5,T6 are the three grading periods that make up Semester2. This indicates that the course listed in this row is a Semester 2 course.

This column tells you the period of the day

1(A-B) means first period every day.

1(A) would mean this class is first period, for the first 45 minutes.

1(B) would mean this class is first period, for the last 45 minutes.



- If courses are scheduled in a period (1,2,3, or 4) that means the course is a Plan B (hybrid) course. Hybrid courses involve live instruction for at least part of the period. Students are scheduled to attend school one day per week M-Th and participate virtually the other three days during the scheduled class time. All students are expected to complete remote learning on Fridays. The work on Fridays can be done at any time during the day.
- PRHS has some classes taught on an A/B day. During Plan B this means that students in the A section will be in that class the first 45 minutes and students in the B section will be in that class the last 45 minutes. In a traditional school year these classes meet every other day for the full period. Since we are under Plan B we are splitting the A/B day and seeing students every day.
- “Virtual Section” under courses means that the student registered for an online class through UCVirtual, NCVPS or CCP (community college). You can contact your counselor if you do not remember the course you registered for.

Plan D students- PR Virtual Academy Students: students are scheduled to work online from home for the entire first semester.

Example schedule:

This column tells you the period of the day
 1(A-B) means first period every day.
 1(A) would mean this class is first period, for the first 45 minutes.
 1(B) would mean this class is first period, for the last 45 minutes.

VA(A-B) means a traditional virtual course. There is no formal period as students can work on course material each day at flexible times.

T1,T2,T3 are the three grading periods that make up Semester1. This indicates that the course listed in this row is a Semester 1 course.

T4,T5,T6 are the three grading periods that make up Semester2. This indicates that the course listed in this row is a Semester 2 course.

Students who are formally enrolled for first semester in the PR Virtual Academy appear to have an online course called "UCPS Virtual Academy" with Dr. Fisenne as the teacher. This is NOT an actual class, but an identifier that lets us easily identify a PR Virtual Academy student.

- In the schedule above you may note that this PR Virtual Academy student has 3 traditional virtual courses (VA(A_B)), but also has a hybrid course scheduled for 3rd period. This means that the course selected was not available as a traditional virtual course. Students in PR Virtual Academy may have one or more hybrid courses and are expected to log in to Canvas/Microsoft Teams during the class period Mon-Thursday.

Additional Information for ALL students:

- PR Virtual Academy students have only been scheduled for Semester 1 at this time. Schedules for Semester 2, if students choose to continue in PR Virtual Academy, will be done at a later date.
- CCP classes – courses for students taking college classes at SPCC have not been put on schedules yet but there is a place holder on your schedule for the course during the time you are taking the class.
- All students are scheduled in "Homeroom". In a traditional school year students meet with an Advisor during this time to focus on Career/College/Leadership/Social-emotional Learning. During this time period we will be addressing these topics in an alternate format.
- "Please See Your Counselor" is listed if you have an open spot in your schedule that period and need to contact your counselor by email or phone to choose a course.
- The link for schedule correction requests will appear on our PRHS website starting Friday 8/14. Requests will only be considered if your schedule has a class you already passed on it, a course you don't meet the pre-requisites for, or you are missing a course needed to graduate.
