



Creating my Career Path:
Embracing Change in my Journey



Participants are invited to explore creating their futures and embracing the changes that come with them. They can explore how they overcome obstacles and adapt to new situations at home, school, work, or with friends.

Eligibility

Adults and students enrolled in public, private, and parochial schools in states with participating NCCDA state divisions are eligible. A list of participating state divisions is available on the NCCDA website at www.nccda.org.

Contest division areas include:

- Primary Grades K – 2
- Intermediate Grades 3 – 5
- Middle Grades 6 – 8
- Senior Grades 9 – 12
- Adult Student 18 and older enrolled in school
- Open Adult 18 & older (Teachers, parents, professionals, etc)

Each entry should celebrate and inspire career development with a positive tone while emphasizing the national theme.

Requirements for Poems

- Poetic Form: Acceptable poetic forms, e.g. cinquain, free verse, diamante, haiku, limerick, metered, rhyming, blank verse
- Size: Submit each poem on a single sheet of paper 8.5" x 11", 12 point font.

Requirements for Art

- Lettering: Simple bold lettering is preferred. Captions are to be used to convey the theme, attract attention, and to achieve goals of clarity, vigor, and originality. All lettering will be considered part of the design.

Media

- Art 1 (A1): Standard use of ink, pencil, poster paints, magic marker, acrylics, and oils.
- Art 2 (A2): Use of photos, clipart, graphic art software, collage, cut and pasted paper, and mixed media.

- Size: Each poster must be created in 8.5" x 11" format, including mat, to be eligible.

- State Contest winners will be submitted to National Contest by **February 20, 2025**

Judging Process

Criteria

- Judging will be based on originality, creativity, and development of the national theme
- Poems will be evaluated on appropriate form, execution, spelling, and grammar
- Art evaluation will focus on the appropriate use of media, lettering, and basic principles of art.

Please adhere to the size requirements for each entry as many entries are received.

National Awards

National awards will be given to the first, second, and third place winners in the six divisions in both the Poetry and Art Contests. National winners will be recognized on the NCCDA website, www.nccda.org, in May of 2025.

The winning entries will also be on display at the Annual Global Conference to be held in Atlanta, Georgia, June 18–20 2025.

National winners will receive from the National Career Development Association, a certificate, and a special congratulations gift.

UNION COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

! NEW PROTOCOLS FOR UCPS EVENTS

UCPS has experienced a number of safety incidents at athletic events around the county.

For fall sports, UCPS will implement the following protocols.

- Only clear bags, no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" will be allowed in events/games. Medical and baby bags are subject to search.
- Middle and elementary students must be accompanied by an adult (21 years or older) to attend events and games.
- All ticket sales will end at the beginning of halftime or at the mid-point of an event.
- After consulting with law enforcement and district leaders, UCPS will utilize body scanners at events. The use of body scanners will begin in the fall of 2024 at football games.



ABSENCE REPORT FORM

- 1  **Create your account**
 Parent or guardian must create an account. The system will not accept submissions from student email accounts. PRHS will review accounts created to ensure that the email address used matches the parent email address in powerschool. For safety reasons if the email address does not match the known parent email, the account will be deleted. For reference, the school newsletter, the Pirate Press, is sent to the parent email address on file. You can also call the school to check on your email
- 2  **Report Absences**
 Parent or guardian will submit all absences digitally via this Microsoft form.
- 3  **Please Note:**
 - Must submit one day absence at a time.
 - You cannot submit an absence before it occurs
 - You must upload documentation necessary to excuse absences.
 - Porter Ridge High School may only accept a maximum of 5 absences per semester excused with a parent note. After 5 days, only a doctor's note will be accepted.
- 4  **Report absence:**

Attend Today and Achieve Tomorrow

Student attendance at school is expected and is necessary for students to make the most of their learning. Please work with us as we try to teach our students that attendance is required, just as it would be at a job in their future.

- Parents can provide notes for up to five days that a student is absent. After those days PRHS will require a doctor/medical note to excuse the absence.
- An absence will be recorded as unexcused until the note is submitted. Parent notes must be in within five days of the student's return to school.
- If a student misses 8 or more days of school in a semester, whether the absences are excused or unexcused, the student may fail the course due to attendance.
