



IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Arrival and Dismissal

We continue to encourage students and parents to allow extra time to get to school in the morning to ensure they are on time. We kindly ask that students are not dropped off or picked up in the student parking lot or in the bus lot. Only students with a valid parking pass will be permitted to park in the student parking lot.




Students are not to park in the church parking lot across from the school or on the streets in surrounding neighborhoods. All student drop-offs in the morning and pick-ups at dismissal are to be done in the car rider line. We also ask that all cars pull all the way down in the car rider line as directed by staff. This allows more students to access their rides at one time, thereby speeding up the pick-up process.



Drop Off Table

Should a student need an item brought from home, parents are permitted to do so. There is a drop-off table inside the main foyer. The school will not be responsible for any items left in this drop-off area. Classes will not be interrupted for pick-ups. Make sure to label them with your child's first and last name. Food drop-offs by parents or outside delivery services (such as Door Dash, Uber Eats, etc.) will not be permitted. Please plan ahead for events such as a forgotten lunch by arranging to have a balance in the student's cafeteria account. No other deliveries will be accepted for students...this includes flowers and other gifts.


