## Graduation Rehearsal: Friday, June 9th 12:00pm

All seniors participating in commencement are required to attend rehearsal on Friday, June 9th at 12:00pm. The check-in table will open at 11:15am by the gym doors near the student entrance of the school. All students will be directed where to report after checking in.

## Graduation: Monday, June 12th at 8:00am

Weddington High School's Class of 2023 Commencement will be held on Monday, June 12th at 8:00am at the high school stadium. Seniors are expected to arrive and line up by 7:15am. Students may park in the student parking lot as early as 7:00am, check in at the table in the gym, and then proceed to their assigned pod for line up. We will begin the processional at 7:45am. It is extremely important that students arrive by 7:15am in order to ensure students are able to check in and be in line for the processional.

## **INCLIMATE WEATHER CONTINGENCY PLAN:**

Graduation will take place Monday, June 12th at 8:00am as planned, however, it is possible that there could be a minor delay or modification to the program depending on the weather. We will continue monitoring the weather throughout the week and over the weekend. Any delays to the 8:00am start time would be communicated Monday morning by no later than 6:00am via a connect ed text message and through our school social media platforms. Students, parents, and guests are encouraged to follow Weddington High School social media Monday morning for any updates.

Dress code for students is business casual. Males should wear a collared shirt and females a dress, skirt, or dress pants. Flip Flops should not be worn. Ladies should not wear heels as they will be walking on soft grass. Ladies should affix the white collar that comes with the graduation gown. All cords will be distributed at graduation rehearsal. Only school distributed cords may be worn.

Graduation caps are not to be decorated.

### **Graduation Tickets:**

Each graduating senior was allotted 8 tickets to the ceremony which they were required to claim from the school website and distribute a QR code to their attendees. All guests will need a ticket in order to attend. We ask that you please have your mobile/paper ticket ready to be scanned upon arriving at the ticket booth. **The gates will open at 7:00am.** All guests are encouraged to arrive early to ensure you get a parking spot and find a seat prior to the ceremony beginning promptly at 8:00am.

## **Graduation Parking:**

Parking is available at Weddington Elementary, Weddington Middle and Weddington High School. We highly encourage guests to park at the elementary and middle school lots due to their close proximity.

Although there are handicap parking spots at each of the parking locations, all individuals requiring additional assistance are asked to park at **Weddington Middle School**. There will be a golf cart shuttle for those who need assistance. Handicap loading/unloading will occur in the handicap spots in the front middle school lot.

Due to the number of guests attending graduation, parking will be limited. Families are encouraged to carpool and maximize the number of guests per vehicle.

## **Senior Collections:**

Seniors will not be allowed to walk in the graduation ceremony if their school account has not been cleared. Our bookkeeper, Mrs. Tina Starnes, will be available following graduation practice to assist students with clearing any outstanding fees. It is extremely important that all seniors ensure that they have turned in all textbooks, library materials, Chromebook and charger, and any outstanding fees by the end of the day Friday, June 9th.



## SENIOR GRADUATION PICTURES

The group panoramic cap and gown photo taken in the stadium will be added to each senior's cap and gown profile in Cady. Parents can either add the panoramic onto their cap and gown order or they can purchase it a la carte for \$30 by skipping ahead to step 4 in the ordering process. Cady studio will also be taking pictures at graduation of each senior walking across the stage and holding their diploma after walking off the stage. Any student with an existing profile with CADY will receive an email with a link to their posed graduation photos 24 hours after the ceremony. ## **REPORT CARDS**

We will mail report cards to all students in grades 9-11 on Thursday, June 15th. Seniors will receive their final report card and transcripts in their graduation packets at graduation on Monday, June 12th.

## 2023-2024 PARKING PASS INFORMATION

As we move into summer, we will begin preparing for the student parking pass application process. In late June, we will begin communicating the student parking pass application process via school website, social media, and a message to parents. Included in this communication in late June will be the date/time that the parking pass application process will open.

## INFORMATION FOR THE CLASS OF 2024

## From the Counseling Department:

- 1. <u>Brag Sheet</u> please refer to your Scoir account to complete the Brag Sheet. The Brag Sheet will serve as the foundation of college applications, admission essays, personal statements, and when preparing for interviews. Once logged into Scoir, click on the three lines in the top right-hand corner, scroll down, and select "surveys" to begin. Scoir will automatically save your work while in progress. Do NOT hit "submit" until the entire survey is finished. Once submitted, the information shared will be accessible via the respective Scoir account. A completed Brag Sheet is required of any student requesting a letter of recommendation from a WHS teacher and/counselor. No brag sheet = no letter. Please see attached documents for further assistance.
- 2. <u>Scoir</u> Parents! Ask your child to invite you to Scoir! To learn more about Scoir, <a href="https://www.youtube.com/results?search\_query=scoir">https://www.youtube.com/results?search\_query=scoir</a>
- 3. <u>TA (Teacher Assistant)</u> Students who would like to TA either first or second semester need to speak with the teacher they would like to TA for. If the teacher approves, the teacher will complete the TA application. Once complete and submitted, the administration will approve/deny the request. If approved, the data manager creates a TA section for the teacher and the counselor withdraws the student from a course to meet the request. This takes place over the summer and into the first 10 days of the school year.
- 4. <u>FLEX</u> The FLEX day option will be available during semester two. To be eligible for FLEX, students must complete the FLEX application by June 5th. The FLEX application can be found in Scoir. Once logged into Scoir, click on the three lines in the top right-hand corner, scroll down and select "surveys" to locate and complete the application. Once submitted, counselors will review the application, student transcript and completed graduation requirements. If approved, the data manager creates a FLEX section, and the counselor withdraws the student from a course(s) specified by the student. This takes place over the summer and into the first 10 days of the school year.


