#### 2022-2023 ACCOUNTABILITY RESULTS

On behalf of the Weddington High School staff, we want to share some exciting news! The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction released the certified accountability results for the 2022-2023 school year. We are proud to announce that Weddington High School was again awarded a **School Performance Grade of A** and **EXCEEDED** composite growth expectations! I encourage you to spend time studying this expansive report.

As a whole, UCPS continues to outperform the state and the 12 largest districts in multiple testing and accountability areas. Overall UCPS proficiency on state assessments was 69.3 percent, ranking UCPS the highest among the 12 largest districts and number two across the state. #### FALL CURRICULUM NIGHT

This year's curriculum night will be held on **Wednesday, September 13th, at 5:30 pm**. All parents are asked to report directly to your child's first period class. The event will begin promptly at 5:30 pm with first period teachers showing a virtual message from Dr. Kraftson and the WHS PTSO. After the message from Dr. Kraftson and the PTSO, parents will then follow their child's schedule beginning with first period for a 10 minute presentation from the teacher. This will be an opportunity for teachers to provide an overview of their course content and class expectations.

Please note that the teachers will not be available for parent/teacher conferences during this event. PARENTS...please be sure to take a picture of your child's schedule on your phone, and bring it to this event so that you are able to navigate his/her schedule.

#### SENIOR INFORMATION SESSION

6:45pm-7:15pm - Senior Information Session in Auditorium

The Weddington School Counseling Department is excited to invite seniors and parents to an in person Senior Information session immediately following curriculum night Wednesday, September 13th from 6:45pm – 7:30pm in the WHS Auditorium.

All seniors and parents/guardians are invited to attend. Presentation topics will include but not limited to: Scoir, common app, college application process, writing the college essay, requesting a transcript, letters of recommendation, etc.

### VISITORS/DROP OFFS

All visitors to the school must enter through the front doors of the school using the video doorbell system. All visitors must check in at the main office during the hours of 7:30 am and 4:00 pm, which are the main office hours on days that school is in session.

#### Forgotten Items/Drop Offs/Deliveries:

Students are encouraged to arrive at school prepared. Should a student need an item brought from home, parents are permitted to do so. There will be a drop off table inside the main foyer just outside the main office. The school **will not be responsible for any items left in this drop off area**. Classes will not be interrupted for pick ups. Make sure to label them with your child's first and last name. Please plan ahead for events such as a forgotten lunch by arranging to have a balance in the student's cafeteria account. No deliveries will be accepted for students...this includes food, flowers, and other gifts. Outside delivery services such as DoorDash, Uber Eats, etc will not be allowed access to drop off items for students.

#### ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL / TRANSPORTATION

Weddington High School students may enter the building each day at 7:15 a.m. <u>Entrances will remain</u> <u>locked until that time.</u>

#### Car Riders:

At arrival time, students are to be dropped off in front of the school. Please help us to keep car traffic flowing efficiently by facilitating the quick but safe exit of your child from your car and by pulling your car up as far as possible in the line. Students will enter through the main entrance of the school. At dismissal time, students will exit the building from the main entrance. School personnel will be supervising the process, but as is the case with arrival, we encourage you to stress with your child/children the importance of safe habits. Please take note that parking and student drop off/pick-up are not permitted in the student parking lot, staff lot, gravel lot, or the church across the street during arrival and dismissal times. Additionally, the surrounding neighborhoods have requested that we remind students and parents that neighborhood streets are not for parking and dropping off / picking up students. Vehicles may be subject to being towed at the owner's expense.


#### Student Drivers:

#### Senior Pictures Information

There are 3 ways to get your senior pictures taken this year.

- Between now and December 3rd you can book a session at Cady studios by visiting their website at <u>https://store.cady.com/</u>. There are several different packages available ranging in a variety of prices. The basic session package is \$30 and includes several poses of the senior tux/drape yearbook photo, cap/gown photo, and 1 scene of your choice. With this basic package, seniors will also be able to select the tux/drape photo they want to be included in the yearbook.
- 2. Cady Studios will be coming to Weddington High School in the media center on October 16th to host a Roadshow. Please note this date is a teacher workday and not a school day for students. These sessions can also be booked online at <u>https://store.cady.com/</u>. Just make sure to select Oct 16th as the date and Weddington High School as the location. At the Roadshow, the traditional packages which range from \$30 to \$80 will be offered. The basic session package is \$30 and includes several poses of the senior tux/drape yearbook photo, cap/gown photo, and 1 scene of your choice. With this basic package, seniors will also be able to select the tux/drape photo they want to be included in the yearbook.
- 3. Last, we will offer a make-up session in late November. The date of this make-up session has not been determined. At this make-up session, students will only get a single shot of the tux/drape photo taken. Seniors will not be able to select the photo to be put in the yearbook.

\*\*Seniors who do not get their senior picture taken by December 3rd, 2023 <u>will not</u> be included in the yearbook.
