Girls on the Run is a positive youth development program for girls in 3rd-5th grade and Heart & Sole is for girls in 6th-8th grade. Teams meet twice a week for 10 weeks and follow our research-based curricula, which includes dynamic discussions, activities and running games. Registration ends when the season starts or once a site is full. Each team must have between 8-15 girls.

# Financial Aid Form

## Financial Aid Policy Statement: (Please read carefully!)

It is the policy of Girls on the Run of Union County to offer our program to all girls who desire to participate in the program regardless of their family's financial status. Families who are unable to pay the full program registration fees will be awarded financial assistance based on their income. Scholarships are granted on a first come, first served basis and may be limited by the resources available at the time of application.

### Eligibility and Application Process:

1. Applicants must register for the program by completing the registration form (on reverse side).
2. Applicants who are applying for a scholarship for the 4<sup>th</sup> season may be placed on a waitlist (if needed) in order to accommodate first-time scholarship applicants.
3. Assistance will be awarded on the basis of financial need. View the chart below for the adjusted scholarship program fee.
4. Turn in registration form and adjusted scholarship fee to complete registration.
