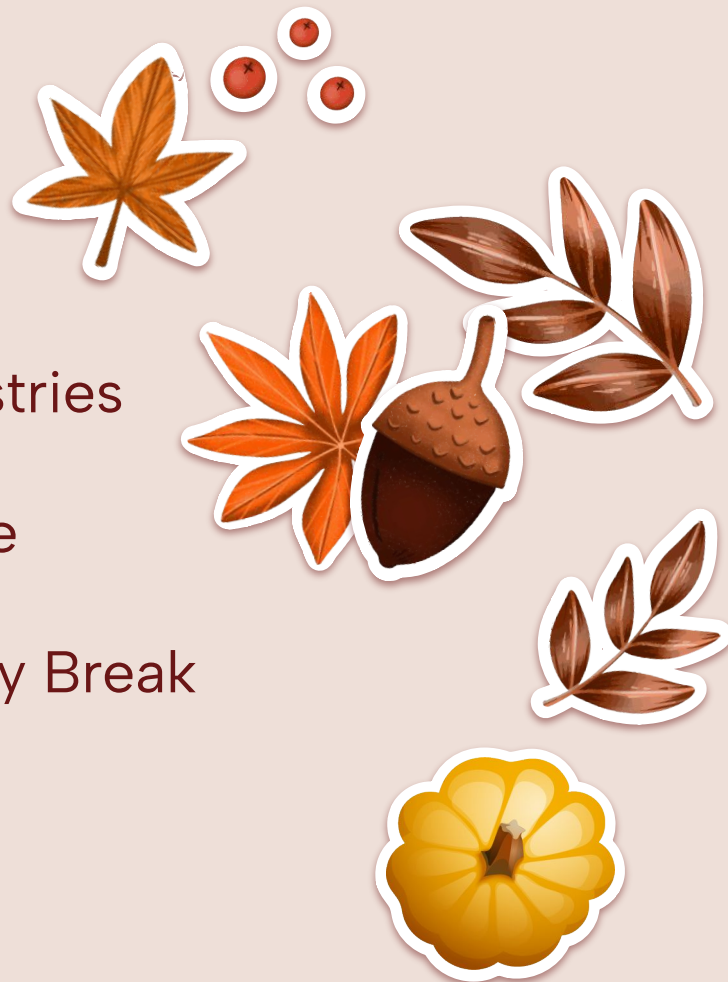

School-Home Connection



Kindergarten

Practice writing their name. Recognizing letters and sounds they have learned in class. Practice rhyming words. Practice tricky words. In math, practice counting from 1-50, writing numbers to 20. Describe 2D shapes.




Grade 1

Practice counting and writing numbers to 150. In reading students need to practice reading, writing and recognizing their letter sounds. They receive practice activities every night. **DLI**– receive homework each week.

Grade 2

Check your child's folder and agenda each night. Students receive homework throughout the week.





School-Home Connection




Grade 3

Check newsletter on the hub every Friday. Read for 20 minutes each night.

Practice fluency with multiplication.

DLI-Practice reading in spanish.



Grade 4


Checking homework daily. Practice fluency with multiplication. Read every night for 20 minutes. We encourage parents to listen and to answer questions.

Grade 5

Practice fluency with addition, subtraction and multiplication facts. Students are to read every night for 20 minutes.

Read over science notes nightly.

DLI-Practice reading in spanish.
