

# WHS Exam Exemption Checklist

High school students will not be required to take a teacher-made final exam in a course in the following situations:

- The student has an average of 90 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 3 absences (excused or unexcused) in the class.
- The student has an average of 80 or above the week prior to the administration of the exam and has no more than 2 absences (excused or unexcused) in the class.

Please Note:

- Exam exemptions are not available in courses which require the administration of an End of Course or state mandated final exam.
- Students enrolled in AP courses will still be required to take the AP exam.
- Teacher-made tests do not include any developed and administered by NCDPI (i.e. EOC, CTE, field tests, etc.), or any AP exams.

**The attendance in PowerSchool is the official record of attendance. Our attendance counselor, Mrs. Glenna Bowen, has updated and coded the absences according to UCPS Board of Education policy.**
