(If you have children in different classes, you can select the time that best meets your needs)

- In order to assist with flow of traffic, parents should come to the school entering Western Union School Road from Robinson Rd /Potter Rd/Old Waxhaw Monroe Rd. Enter the school via the "s" curve for the morning car rider line. You will follow the "s" curve, up to the front of the school and continue to in front of the gym. You will exit the school by turning right to go toward Hwy 75.
- Parents should not arrive at the school any more than 10 minutes before the time your class is scheduled to begin.
- If you could have a sign (car rider sign or similar to) in the window of the child's first and last name, that will help us with announcing the students as they are approaching.
- When the car reaches the top of the morning car rider line (awning at the auditorium), the child can get out of car to pick up certificate or roll down window for the certificate to be handed to them.

- There will be no handshakes, hugs, etc. We will also not be able to have materials or gifts dropped off or picked up at this time.
