FAFSA

- Opens in December
- Must file every year
- Before completing:
 - Create FSA ID (www.StudentAid.gov)
 - Consent for tax info from 2022 to be linked from IRS to FAFSA
 - Know which schools you will list to receive your Financial Aid info
 - Can list up to 20 schools

COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- Complete RDS and have Residency Certification Number ready
- Apply through CFNC's website
- List the school on your FAFSA application
- Update SCOIR account with name of school and that you have applied
- Take placement test (if needed)
- Meet with Advisor to register for classes
- Apply for Scholarships
 - Notify Mrs. Butera or Ms. MItchell if awarded scholarships

FOUR-YEAR UNIVERSITY

- Research schools and application deadlines
- Complete RDS and FAFSA (list schools on FAFSA)
- Apply through CFNC, school's website, CommonApp
- Update SCOIR
- Work on essays (if needed)
- Ask teachers for Letters of Recommendation (at least 2 weeks before deadline)
- Pay application fees
- Apply for Scholarships
 - Notify Mrs. Butera or Ms. MItchell if awarded scholarships
