

CATA Bullying Policy

Definition of Bullying: “Bullying is a form of harassment. Bullying means the repeated intimidation of others by the real or threatened infliction of physical, verbal, written, electronically transmitted or emotional abuse or through attacks on the property of another. Bullying may include, but is not limited to, verbal taunts, name-calling and put-downs, extortion of money or possessions, implied or stated threats.”

Central Academy is committed to enforcing a no bullying policy as specified by Union County Public Schools. All CATA students have been made aware of and reviewed UCPS bullying policy.

To report an incident of bullying:

Students: Either report directly to a guidance counselor or fill out a confidential Bullying Incident report that is available in the guidance office.
