

Cougar Council Meeting Minutes March 1, 2011 Rescheduled Board Meeting

The Rescheduled Board Meeting of the Cougar Council PTSO of Central Academy High School was called to order by Vice President Adam Dailey at 7:10pm on Tuesday March 1, 2011, in the Media Center. 4. Then we discussed the items that still need to be finished.
 - Treva Shaffer is working on the Sashes
 - Tech Theater students are working on the road sign
 - Tammy and Karen are working on the flowers
 - More cupcakes will be needed
 - Cups for punch
 - Another large punch bowl
 - Mr. Miller is asking a friend to do the tickets
 - Newspaper Advertisement – Enquirer Journal – need approval for \$180 for 3x5 size ad. Teresa Edwards made a motion that we allot \$180 for the newspaper ad and if the ad happens to cost more for any reason, that amount needs to be brought back to Cougar Council for sustaining vote. The motion was seconded by Adam Dailey and passed with unanimous vote.

5. An administrator needs to be on hand to lock the building when clean-up is over, preventing last year's required wait until someone came with the key at almost 11pm.

Teresa Edwards made a motion that we adjourn our meeting, which passed unanimously, after a second by virtually all other members and unanimous vote; therefore, the meeting was adjourned at 7:40pm.
