Dr. Poole opened meeting speaking about the following:

New School Improvement Plan

- Test data

NC High School Accountability Model

- EOC's do not change
 - Algebra II standard will be based on teacher passing student
 - CTE students will have to take a Work Key assessment
 - Need better grasp of this assessment
 - ACT, same
- School's assessment will be based on a standard letter grade of:
 - A: 90 – 100
 - B: 80 – 89
 - C: 70 – 79
 - D: 60 – 69
 - F: Less than 60 points
- Growth is equal to all 5 factors points added together then divided by: 5
- ACT base line information is
 - ACT preparation class
 - No accountability if students take or do not take ACT
 - Eaton: Reading scores are low and should not be that low
 - MSL postponed—graded locally
- Parent Surveys
 - Overall CATA performance is 99%
 - Additional information will be discussed next meeting
 - Dr. Poole has all data in his office
 - Tardy policy
 - Dress code
 - New Technology
 - Invested in by CATA, CTE
 - 1 to 1 laptop:
 - Provided to 9th graders this year
 - For remaining grades, soon to come
 - MSL for all subjects
 - Known as Common Assessments

- Postponed to second semester
 - Locally given and graded
 - EOC scores will arrive Oct 2013
 - MSL & Standard 6 will populate
 - EOG 30 – 70, spilt
 - Non EOG: 100% growth
- Professional Learning Communities
 - Groups of teachers/administrators sent to training
 - Each academy will have a PLC
- Additional Information:
 - Dr. Poole meet with Dr. Little, and Robert Filter to discuss CATA's fate. CATA will not be going anywhere.
 - Teacher prep academy has been phased out here at CATA—but has relocated to other high schools
 - School year 2013 – 2014, CATA will no longer have a teacher prep academy
 - Medical academy will expand, 2013 – 2014
 - All medical teachers have moved on. Dr. Poole has hired:
 - One out of 3 required teachers
 - 18 additional medical students, 2014-2015
 - One large pathway similar to "Project Lead The Way"
