Minutes of General Board Meeting  
January 8, 2013

The Cougar Council PTSO met in the media center of Central Academy of Technology and Arts on Tuesday, January 8, 2013. Present were Deb Christensen, Christa Dailey, Agnes Florian, Wendy Duemmler, Susan Montgomery, Karen Morgal, Nancy Bishop, Adam Dailey, and Teresa Edwards. The meeting was called to order by President Deb Christensen at 7:09 pm.

Deb Christensen welcomed everyone to the first meeting of the New Year. Pseudo-minutes, Deb's notes from the last meeting, were emailed previously. Deb Christensen reviewed those notes and minutes were approved with no changes.

Treasurer's Report: Current Balance \$1,190.35. Adam Dailey moved to approve the Treasurer's Report as written. Second by Wendy Duemmler. Approved by the board.

Senior Breakfast – PTSO is sponsoring breakfast for the Senior Class on Monday, January 14<sup>th</sup>. Ten parents have signed up so far. Drinks will be purchased using our gift cards. We will be serving 200 students, and will be serving breakfast from 8am until 8:45am. Bagels and muffins are still needed. Nancy Bishop suggested that we eliminate cereal and milk from this breakfast to make it simpler and easier to clean up afterwards.

Fundraising Update: Hat Day yielded \$125. Nancy Bishop brought the little monkey from Dollar Tree that we are considering selling at lunch for Valentine's. Monkeys will be delivered to last block class. Tags will be provided, which purchaser will fill out with Student Name, 4<sup>th</sup> Block Teacher, and Purchaser's name. We will purchase them for \$1.00 and sell them for \$2.00. Delivery will be Valentine's Day, Thursday the 14<sup>th</sup>. Ticket sales will be Feb 5-8 during lunches. We will tag and sort them at the meeting on the 12<sup>th</sup>. Deb Christensen will deliver the bags of monkeys to the 4<sup>th</sup> block classes on the 14<sup>th</sup>. Agnes will do a signup Genius for help selling those four days. Wendy Duemmler made a motion to purchase eight boxes of monkeys, for \$36 each, second by Susan Montgomery, all approved.
