The end of this grading period is April 14 so please get all excuse notes in by that date!!

If you have submitted a note for a "family emergency," it will NOT be excused. Only funerals for immediate family members can be excused.








<u>Cavalettes Dance Team</u> <u>Meeting</u>




Internship Applications for the 22-23 school year are now open!




