Student Tech Issues


If students have tech issues with their chromebooks, getting logged in to Google, Canvas, NCEdCloud, Teams, ZScaler, or anything else – they should reach out for assistance and not wait! We have a tech team readily addressing these issues. We often hear students say they've been having the same issue for weeks and we wonder why they never reached out.

At the beginning of the year we encouraged any student with a tech issue to enter a help desk ticket and wait to be contacted. That system has evolved over the fall semester and now we ask any student with a tech issue who comes to school to come to the MC with their problem as soon as they are at school. If a student is Plan D Virtual – that is the best time to enter the help desk ticket – or they could also call school and ask for the MC to get assistance.

Our technician Mr. Schevikhoven has posted office hours in the building but even if he is not there MC staff are often able to assist. Also be aware that UCPS offers many helpful tutorials to assist students with common issues such as logging in, the ZScaler, or printing <u>at this website!</u> Mr. Schevikhoven is at CHS in the MC Mondays and Wednesdays 8:00am – noon and Tuesdays and Thursdays 12:30 – 3:00pm.

Mid-Year Transcript Information

Cavs, attached is a google link for mid-year transcript requests. Prior to completing the document make sure you check the college(s) website you have applied to and follow their instructions. Please only list those colleges/universities that require or request a mid-year transcript. Also, as a reminder transcripts cannot be sent out until grades have been finalized and rank has been updated. We anticipate sending transcripts through SCOIR during mid-to-late January - you can check your SCOIR account for updates.
