Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday

Reminder: In observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day, UCPS schools and offices will be closed Monday, January 21. Traditional schools will have a teacher workday on Tuesday, January 22. We welcome all students back to second semester on Wednesday, January 23, 2019. Students should report to homerooms. Homeroom lists may be found here.

Second Semester Schedule Changes

Students who would like to be considered for a schedule change should complete the change request form found on the Naviance home page. Students should print the form and follow the instructions listed. Completed change request forms should be taken to Guidance starting Thursday, January 24 during the period for which the student is requesting the change. All students will follow their current schedule the first day of the semester, January 23. If they have a "Please see your counselor" message on a block of their schedule, they should report to Guidance the first day of the semester during that block.

Mid-Term Report/Transcript Procedures for Seniors

The Transcript Request Form for mid-year grades will be available in Guidance next week. Mid-year requests will be prepared after GPA and Class Rank have been updated. This information is projected to be available mid-February. There will be no charge for mid-year transcripts sent to the universities to which you have previously applied this school year. Some schools ask you to self-report or do not require this information; therefore, mid-year transcripts should only be sent to universities that have requested this information.

Transcripts

We are in the midst of regular decision college application deadlines for Seniors. Students should be sure to request and pay for their transcripts at least 10 business days prior to the deadline.

Second Semester Curriculum Night

Mark your calendars – second semester Curriculum Night will be held Monday, February 11 from 6 to 7:30 p.m. After a PTSO meeting in the Auditorium, parents will be free to follow a mini-version of their child's day, meet the teachers, and learn about the curriculum.
