## Important Final Exam Information

Final exams begin Monday, January 10<sup>th</sup> and conclude Friday, January 14<sup>th</sup>. All exams will begin at 8:10 a.m. and will end at approximately 12 p.m. Once testing is complete for the entire building, lunch will be served. Following lunch, review sessions for the next day's exam will be held. It is a CHS expectation that all students attend the review.

The schedule for exams is as follows: January 10<sup>th</sup>, 1<sup>st</sup> block exam. January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> block exam. January 12<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> block exam. January 13<sup>th</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> block exam. Make-up exams will be given on Friday, January 14<sup>th</sup>.

For early dismissal, students must provide his/her test administrator with a parent signed note prior to the start of the exam. If a note isn't provided, students must stay the full day or a parent may check them out after testing has concluded for the entire building. We will not accept phone calls and/or emails for early dismissal from parents on the day of testing. Transportation will run on a normal schedule.

Exam tips: Be on time! Students should be in their testing locations by 8:10 a.m. Students arriving late will not be admitted to exams once testing has begun. As a reminder, final exams count as 25% of the overall semester grade. Attendance is very important.

Students will need their laptops and their chargers each day and a calculator if taking an exam where it is permitted. All students are encouraged to get a good night's sleep each night and have a healthy breakfast each morning.

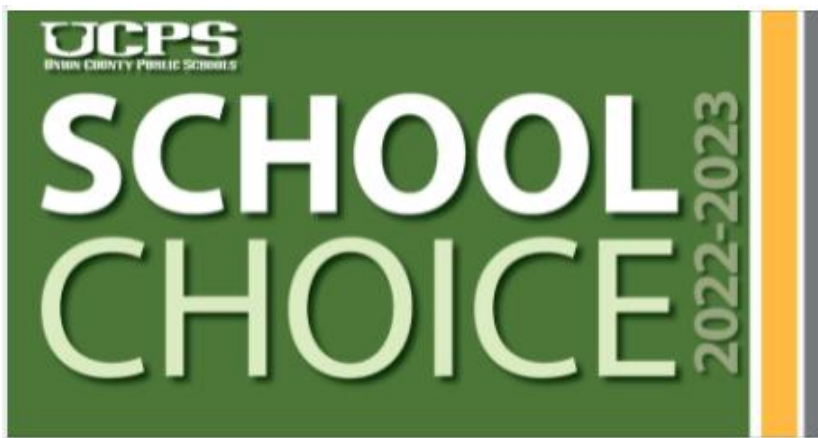
## Grinch 5K

- Must have demonstrated scholastic achievement with a 2.5 or higher unweighted GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Must have demonstrated leadership, excellence of character, integrity and community involvement
- Must file FAFSA as part of the application
