Attendance Reminders

CHS families are reminded that excuse notes should be turned in to the front office on the day the student returns from the absence. If a medical appointment is involved, a note from the doctor/dentist/therapist/etc. office should always be provided. Parent notes for illness should be submitted if the student is out sick and does not require a visit to the doctor. For College Visits, please remember that juniors and seniors may have up to 2 college visits per year. While on the college visit, the student must REQUEST a note from the school. Most schools have form letters that they are happy to give out upon request. If you have any questions about attendance, please email michelle.rutowski@ucps.k12.nc.us. Students who have 8 or more absences in any class may fail that class for attendance. Those students should see Ms. Rutowski immediately during their lunch break or after school.



Chromebook Video

At the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year, each student was issued a Lenovo N23 Chromebook and charger. These Chromebooks have protective cases that should not be removed at any time. If the case is removed, the student will become ineligible for insurance claims, and will therefore be charged for any damages to their Chromebook. 

Did you know that your CABC membership helps pay for all the field maintenance at both Cuthbertson Middle and High Schools?




