

Academic Awards Ceremonies

The Academic Awards ceremonies from spring semester of last school year are being held during Cavalier period this week 10:50-11:30 according to this schedule:

10th grade – Tuesday, October 1. 11th grade – Wednesday, October 2. 12th grade – Friday, October 4.

Students who meet the following qualifications will be awarded a letter. Letters will be awarded at the conclusion of each academic semester. Students who meet the qualifications more than once will be awarded a gold bar to pin on the letter for each semester during which they meet the qualifications.

Requirements for earning an Academic Letter:

- The student must be in the 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
- The student must have an overall semester average of 90, computed by averaging the grades received in all courses in which the student is enrolled. The student may earn no semester grade less than "85" to be considered.
- In determining overall average and minimum grade requirements for students taking AP courses, five (5) points should be added to the numerical grade received for the semester for each AP Course.
