Cross Country Finale



The Cross Country team competed in the State Championship to close their season last Saturday. The men's race opened the morning, with our CAVS finishing 3rd overall among the Top 24 teams in NC 3A. Mickey Schihl and Gage Austin led the way with Top-10, All-State performances, and Shaun Raughley, Davis Seik, William Walsh, Keegan Burr, and Finn O'Shea rounded out the lineup. In total, 4 CAVS Men finished among the Top 20 scorers in the race. In the women's race, our Cavs claimed their 2nd consecutive State Championship Title, and their 4th consecutive Top-2 finish. Gabriella Castro led the Cavs with a 2nd place individual finish in a new school record 5K time of 18:01, with Lily Nasta also earning All-State honors. Marissa Bosland, Leah Helms, Alyssa Preisano, Madeline Hill, and Kaitlyn St. Hilaire completed the Championship effort. In total, 5 Cavs Ladies finished among the Top 20 scorers in the race.

Chromebooks Zscaler @ Home



Google has changed the ways applications are filtered and web-based learning tools are accessed. As a result, students will be prompted to authenticate to the UCPS Zscaler mobile filter before accessing the internet from home. This change was necessitated in order to correctly filter devices away from school buildings. Please see the sample below and notice that the "@student" is not in this authentication.

Attendance Reminders

How many absences does your son or daughter have? Are they excused or unexcused? It matters!

- Students who have an A average and no more than 2 unexcused absences or a B average and no more than 1 unexcused absence at the end of the semester may be eligible to exempt some of their exams!
- Students who have more than 8 absences in a class (even if some of them were excused) are in danger of failing that class for attendance, and must see Ms. Rutowski immediately.

Students should ALWAYS turn in an excuse note to the front office after an absence. If your son or daughter has forgotten to turn in some of his or her notes, please have them turn them in to the front office right away! Remember to submit a:

- Doctor/Dentist/Orthodontist/Therapist note if the absence included a medical appointment.
- Parent note for illness if the student did not have to go to the doctor.
- Note from the College for a Junior/Senior College visit. (up to 2 per school year)
- Parent note for death in the immediate family (parent, grandparent, sibling).
- Parent note for a Religious holiday.
- Court note for legal proceeding




