We are asking for TOTAL donations of 170 non-refrigerated whole pies. Whether you love to bake or prefer to provide a store-bought pie, all donations are welcome and greatly appreciated! Please note, we cannot accept frozen items or any pies that need refrigeration or additional preparation. Please have pies cooked and ready to eat. If homemade, please be sure to label it so we know the flavor.

We also need two volunteers to help with the pie collection from 7:00am-8:15am. Please meet near the main office.

Pies may be dropped off on Monday, November 19th, in three places:

- 1) The front car rider line from 7:15am-8:00am
- 2) The side car rider line from 7:15am-8:00am
- 3) The main office from 7:15am-3:15pm

Pie drop-off is SUPER EASY. We will have volunteers stationed in the morning car lines to collect pies. Pies may also be dropped off in the CHS front office by 3:15 pm that day. Pies will be distributed to the teachers and staff on Tuesday, November 20th.
