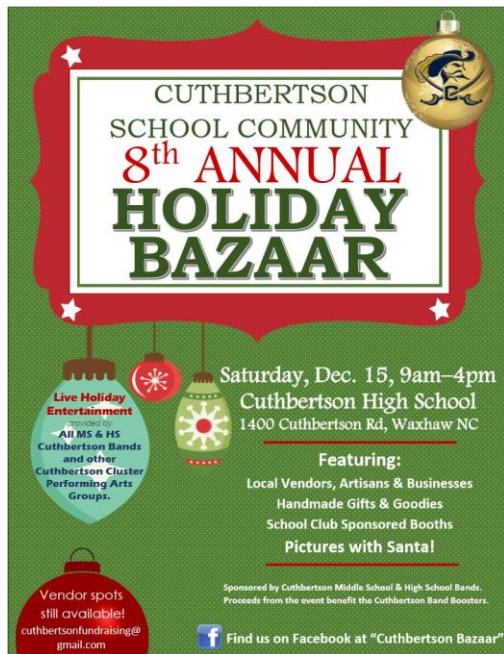

Cuthbertson Hires Carroll to lead Lacrosse Program



Coach James Carroll has spent the past 10 years coaching youth sports including softball, soccer, baseball, wrestling and lacrosse. He began his lacrosse tenure as Middle School Boys Lacrosse coach at Sun Valley, where the team finished 3rd in the MS championship. The following year he took a position coaching at Cuthbertson middle school. Under his leadership the program has produced winning seasons in each of his years at the helm.

Growing up a multi-sport athlete, and moving on to play soccer at Molloy College, Coach Carroll discovered the drive to develop as a player that he carries through his programs in consistent growth of his players, while yielding team success.

When asked of his vision for Cavalier Lacrosse he replied, "I believe that Cuthbertson Men's lacrosse can continue to be one of the top programs in N.C. I believe in the athletes that we have and that we can continue to grow on the successes of the past. We have worked over the past few years to build the foundation of sustained success through growth in the middle school program.
