2020-2021 Registration


Students received registration instructions and viewed a registration presentation in homeroom on February 19. The presentation (with voiceover) will be available to view on the CHS Counseling page under the "Registration Information" link. You will also be able to find the registration schedule on this page.

Students will have until March 3 to enter their course requests into Power School. Counselors will begin meeting individually with students March 4. If you or your student has questions, a counselor is available during all lunches in the cafeteria. You may also send questions with them to their registration appointment.

There will be a parent registration information session Monday, February 24 in the auditorium. Information will be tailored to the student's rising grade level: Rising 10th grade: 6-6:30 pm and rising 11th and 12th: 7-7:30 pm. Counselors will be available afterwards in the cafeteria to answer any remaining questions. We look forward to seeing you there!

The ACT will be given to all juniors on Tuesday, February 25. Students should arrive prior to 8:00 a.m., bring two # 2 pencils and an approved calculator.


Winter Track Excels

Ava Studney was our lone individual state champion on the women's side winning the pole vault with a height of 11 feet. Our girls 4 x 200 Victoria Teasley, Addy Benz, Jade McLain, and Mackenzie Townsend and our women's 4 x 400 Mackenzie Townsend, Addy Benz, Presley Worf, and Caroline Palmer also took home state championships on Friday. Our men's track team scored 61 points to take state runner up. We took home state championships in 3 events and Aidan McNally was part of all 3. He was the lone male individual champion winning the 300 dash. 




"LEAP INTO LIGHTS"
