ACT

All CHS 11th grade students will take the ACT during the school day on Tuesday, March 1, 2022. This test is provided at no cost to students and is state-required. All juniors should arrive at school in time to be in their rooms before 8:10 a.m. No students may enter a testing room once testing has begun.

In preparation for the test, <u>all juniors will report to homerooms during Cav period for 2 weeks beginning Monday</u>, February 14 to participate in ACT prep activities. It is very important for all juniors to participate in these sessions – <u>even those students who flex!</u>

In addition, CHS is offering ACT Blitz sessions on Saturday morning, February 26.

- 10:05-12:05 Science
- 12:35-2:35 English/Reading

Attendance Reminders Regarding Appointments

When a student has an appointment with a provider, they MUST send in an actual note from the provider to have the absence excused. If they submit a parent note that says they had an appointment, it will not be excused. We need a note from the actual office where the appointment took place in order to be considered excused.

And remember, DMV and Passport appointments are NOT excused.

Also, please note that absences for "family emergencies" are not excused. UPCS allows absences to be excused that are due to a death in the immediate family of the student upon documentation of the event.

Student Chromebook Inventory

Please be aware that we are starting a district-required schoolwide student chromebook inventory next Tuesday and continuing into the following week. We are conducting this during second block each day and have divided up the school by sections to do a wing at a time.

Please check the schedule below and remind your child to bring their chromebook AND their charger WITH THEIR CASES ON during their day! Their cases have their names on them that we have to scan! We see students remove their cases all the time and that will really cause delays. The inventory team will set up in the lobby of each wing and go class by class to have students file out and go get their items scanned and return directly to class.

It's very important they bring their chromebook with its case attached, and their charger. Items that do not get scanned will get marked "Lost" in inventory and the students will be charged for them in PowerSchool at the conclusion of the inventory process.


Wednesday, March 9 - Makeup day – any student who has not had their items scanned can go get them scanned in the cafeteria during 2nd block.

Registration for the 2022-2023 School Year is right around the corner!

We are excited to kick off Cuthbertson registration for the 22-23 school year! All students will receive a registration worksheet, instructions, transcript and graduation checklist during homeroom next week. Students will complete various activities March 2-7, in preparation for registration. Please review the materials given to your student as they will be used for planning purposes while entering course requests for next year.

The online system will open **March 3** and students will have until **March 14** to enter their course requests in PowerSchool. The online system will lock after school on March 14. **Please note March 11-13 is a maintenance weekend and PowerSchool will be down so plan accordingly and enter course requests in PowerSchool beforehand. If you or your student has questions, a counselor is available during all lunches in the cafeteria. You may also send questions with them to their registration appointment.**

Individual student registration appointments with counselors will begin **March 17**. Juniors will be first, followed by sophomores and then freshmen. Appointments will be grouped by homeroom, please make sure your student attends their assigned day/time and has all of their courses in PowerSchool beforehand. The homeroom registration schedule, and other important information, can be found here as well as on the registration information link on the counseling page of the CHS website. If they do not have courses entered or miss their assigned date/time, there will be one make-up opportunity on April 1st (by grade level).






