
Samaritan's Feet

- Personalized recommendations for instruction and practice to help students fill their knowledge gaps.



ASVAB



Afterwards, the presentation (with voiceover) will be available to view on the CHS Counseling page under the "registration information" link. You will also be able to find the registration schedule on this page as well. Students will have until March 3 to enter their course requests into Power School. Counselors will begin meeting individually with students March 4. If you or your student has questions, a counselor is available during all lunches in the cafeteria. You may also send questions with them to their registration appointment.

There will be a <u>parent registration information session</u> Thursday, February 20th, in the auditorium. Information will be tailored to the student's rising grade level: Rising 10th grade: 6- 6:30 pm and rising 11th and 12th: 7- 7:30 pm. 
"LEAP INTO LIGHTS"
