Registration for the 2022-2023 School Year is right around the corner!

We are excited to kick off Cuthbertson registration for the 22-23 school year! All students received a registration worksheet, instructions, transcript and graduation checklist last week. Students completed various activities March 2-7, in preparation for registration. Please review the materials given to your student as they will be used for planning purposes while entering course requests for next year.

The online system opened **March 3** and students will have until **March 14** to enter their course requests in PowerSchool. The online system will lock after school on March 14. **Please note March 11-13 is a maintenance weekend and PowerSchool will be down so plan accordingly and enter course requests in PowerSchool beforehand.** If you or your student has questions, a counselor is available during all lunches in the cafeteria. You may also send questions with them to their registration appointment.

Individual student registration appointments with counselors will begin **March 17 (THIS THURSDAY)**. Juniors will be first, followed by sophomores and then freshmen. Appointments will be grouped by homeroom, please make sure your student attends their assigned day/time and has all of their courses in PowerSchool beforehand. The homeroom registration schedule, and other important information, can be found [here](#), on the registration information link on the counseling page of the CHS website and is posted in numerous areas around the building (outside of Guidance, next to the elevator between E and G wings, by the entryway of G wing and in the cafeteria). If they do not have courses entered or miss their assigned date/time, there will be one make-up opportunity on April 1st (by grade level).

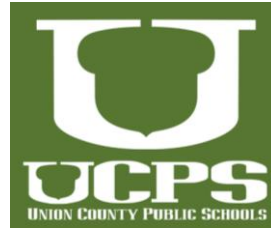

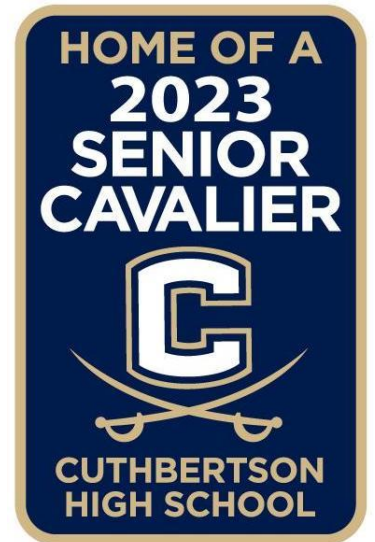

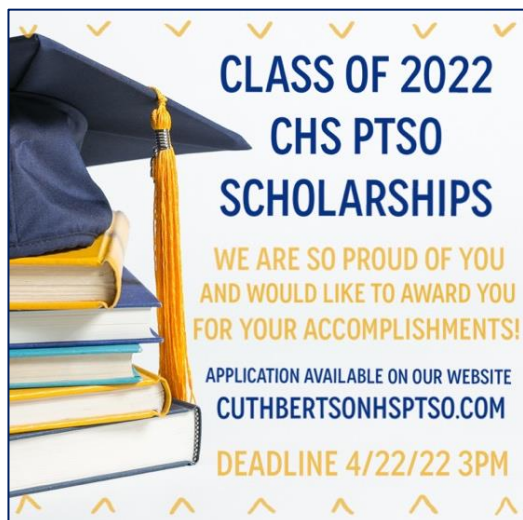
