Registration for the 2022-2023 School Year is underway!

We are excited to kick off Cuthbertson registration for the 22-23 school year! Individual student registration appointments with counselors began March 17. Juniors are first, followed by sophomores and then freshmen. Appointments are grouped by homeroom, please make sure your student attends their assigned day/time and has all of their courses in PowerSchool beforehand.
