Plan on enlisting? We want to recognize those entering the military, please let us know the branch you plan on attending so you can be recognized as well!

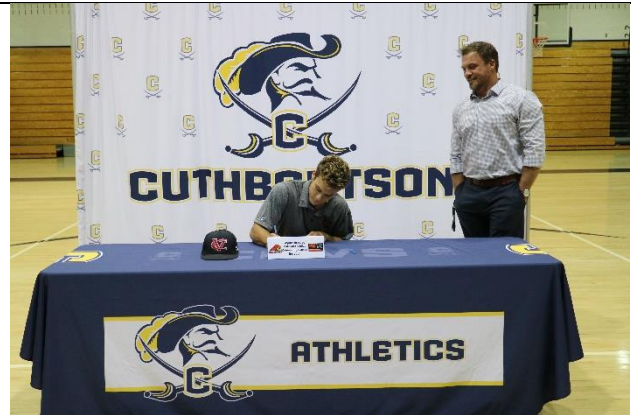

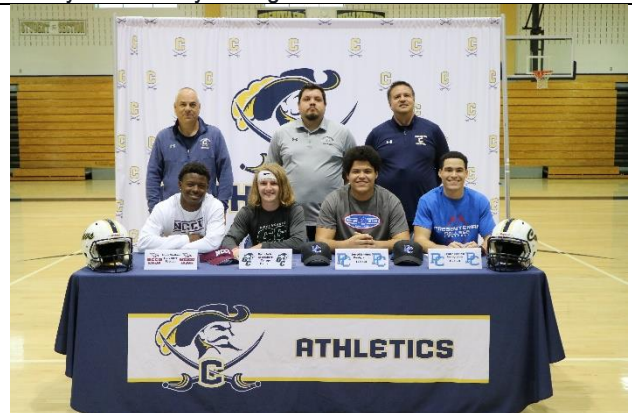
