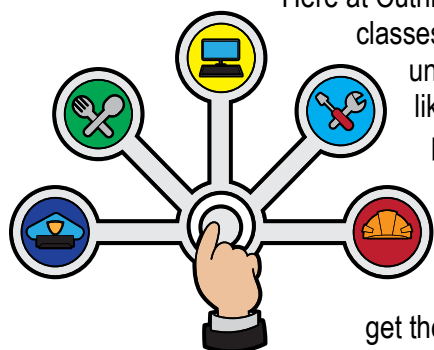




Culinary Summer Camp

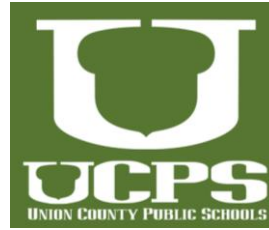

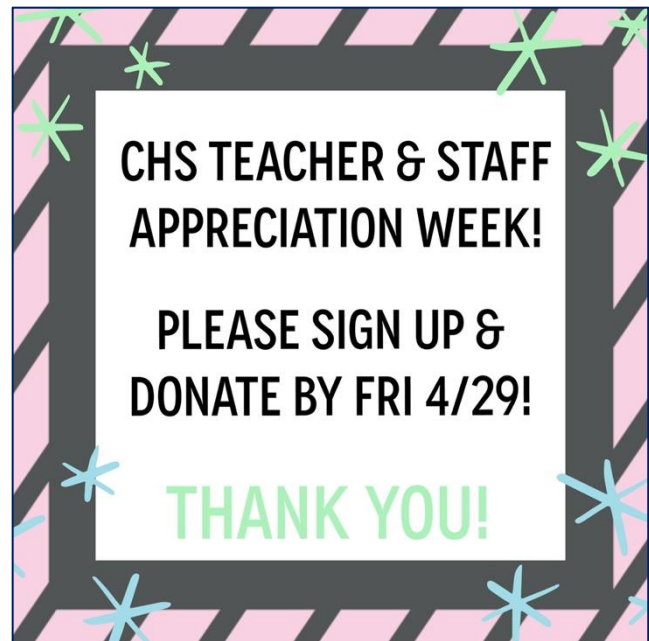

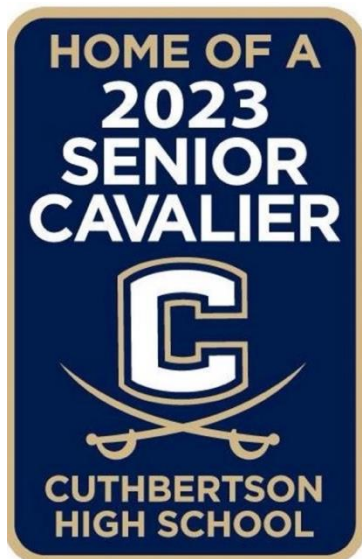
