





Chromebooks and Home Internet Access


A common problem that students may experience with connecting to the Internet from home on their chromebooks is that they will get a gray ZScaler screen asking for a login. This will always happen the first time a student tries to log in at home on the school device. To get past this issue, students should log in with their usual login – LEAVING OUT THE WORD 'student' and using their normal password.

Example: If their regular login is <u>1234567@student.ucps.k12.nc.us</u>, then to get past this ZScaler screen they should type in <u>1234567@ucps.k12.nc.us</u> and then their usual password.



 ALL scholarship information, not just the ones you plan on accepting.
- If you have not done so, please update admission decisions in Naviance. This information is private, but helps populate the graphs so that we can see admission averages for our students.
- Enter the college you will be attending, this is a back-up to the graduation survey. You can do this on your "Colleges I'm Applying To" page, select the college from the drop-down menu in the "College I'm Attending" section.
