Prom


Unfortunately, due to event and venue restrictions, the 2020 Prom is cancelled. We are currently working on processing and returning checks (mail) for students that purchased tickets.

Driver Eligibility Certificates

UCPS has given the approval for schools to begin processing Driving Eligibility Certificates. This process must be done in person and will be processed by appointment only. Please use the form below to schedule your appointment. If you have questions, please reach out to Ms. McAleer at agnes.mcaleer@ucps.k12.nc.us. Appointment Registration Link <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/4090d48a4af2ca5f58-driving>. Once scheduled, bring the following documents to the appointment:

- Completed Driver Education Certificate.
- Proof of address if the current address is different than the one listed on the Driver Education Certificate or the address listed in PowerSchool. Address must be verified for the NC Real ID.

A guardian must be present at the Driving Eligibility Certificate appointment.

-The Driving Eligibility Certificate is only for students that have completed the driving class and behind the wheel training and have received a Driving Education Certificate.

-The Driving Eligibility Certificate is the form you take to the DMV when you take your permit test.

-If you have not yet met the criteria we cannot issue the Driving Eligibility Certificate.

-If you have scheduled an appointment, and have not yet met the criteria, please cancel your appointment to open up a time slot for a student who has completed all portions of Driver's Education.
