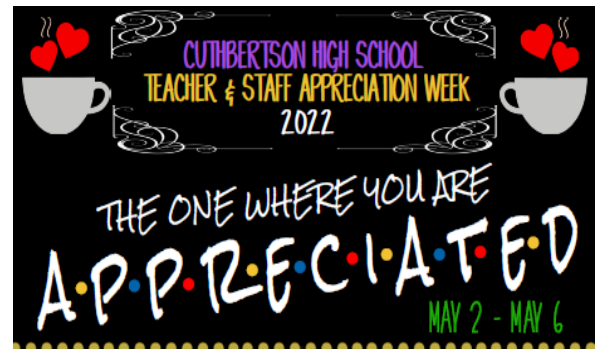


Annual CHS FFA Plant Sale
