





Canvas Parent Readiness Checklist

What is a Canvas Observer?

Ebooks & Media Center Books!



During Plan B, students may browse our online Media Center catalog called "Destiny." A link to Destiny is located on their Student Startup page. If they find a book (a real copy of the book – not an Ebook!) that they would like to check out, they can easily <u>place a hold for it within their own Destiny account</u>.

Both Plan B and Plan D students may do this! Plan D students just need to place their hold, then email <u>Mrs. Tautfest</u> to arrange an outside pickup time!

For Plan B students, the book will be pulled for them, wrapped for sanitation, and left on a table for pickup located outside the MC doors. Students will not be allowed in to browse the shelves on their own due to Covid safety measures.

This reading incentive program has been created to encourage reading for pleasure and to inspire book chats among readers and share ideas of great books to read. All students, whether Plan B or Plan D are all welcome to participate!

When they have read a book, they can self-enroll in the Canvas course using this link: <u>https://tinyurl.com/yy2evmuc</u>. Once enrolled all they have to do is click the arrow at the bottom to enter the book's title, author, and number of pages along with a short description of the book. Then they are free to read others' entries and chat.

Any readers who read over 1000 cumulative pages during the semester will get their names printed on the Chapter Chat academic achievement board displayed in the Media Center and will receive souvenir reader pins! Contact <u>Mrs. Tautfest</u> with any questions.



Here Comes the Bus!

Team UCPS families throughout the district are using the FREE, Here Comes the Bus app to know when the bus will be pulling up to their stop. When downloading the app you will need your child's student ID number (this is their PowerSchool number) and last name. Calculators

TI-84 calculators are considered basic school supplies for high school students. They are used for all math classes as well as the SAT/ACT. TI-84 calculators can be purchased, new or used, from various vendors for a student to use throughout their educational career.

However, if a student has a financial need and needs to borrow one, our Media Center does have a small supply available for checkout. The new online process for this year is for parents to fill out <u>this Google Form</u> if they wish their student to borrow a calculator for the semester.

The Media Center staff will check the form daily, check out a calculator to the students listed, and hand-deliver it to the student in their Math class. The Calculators should be returned at the end of the semester after exams. More details are found in the Google form.

SCOIR (Pronounced "Score")

Our new college and career readiness platform is up and running! UCPS is now using **SCOIR** to send electronic application documents and assist throughout the search and selection process.
