
Attendance on an Assigned Remote Day: Students are expected to access and participate in daily activities. Failure to do so will result in an absence

Union County Public Schools will hold graduations for traditional high schools in stadiums May 28 – June 4, 2021. The graduations will be livestreamed for public viewing.


Mid-Year Transcript Information


