Cross Country

Congratulations to our Men's and Women's Cross Country Teams after an incredible showing at the State Championship meet on January 23. Our guys' team finished 4th out of the 12 finalist teams, making 3 straight years of finishing Top 5 overall in the State. Mickey Schihl and Gage Austin led the way up front, with Will Walsh, Pete Schihl, and Shaun Raughley rounding out the scoring 5 CAVS.

Our ladies' team once again outran everyone, claiming their 3rd straight State Title. Madeline Hill won her 2nd Individual Title, with Alyssa Preisano finishing 2nd and Lily Nasta in 4th; all 3 CAVS earned All-State honors. Behind them, freshmen Justine Preisano and Charlotte Bell completed the scoring 5. Also for the 3rd year in a row, our Ladies were the Top Ranked team for all divisions in the state of North Carolina. Way to go, Cavs!

- Virtual students will pick up their registration materials (transcript, Power School instructions and course worksheet) in the bus parking lot on Friday, February 12th, between noon and 3 pm. If a virtual student is unable to pick up their items that day, their items will be available for pick-up in the main office.
- Students who attend class in person will receive their registration materials during Cav Time on Monday, February 15th, and Wednesday, February 17th.
- During the week of February 15th, all students, in-person and virtual, will view the registration video during Cav Time and have an opportunity for a question and answer session with counselors.

Additional information regarding parent information sessions and individual student appointments will be communicated in the upcoming weeks. Ask your student to be sure to check their emails and listen and/or read the announcements for important details. All eligible high school seniors must meet the following requirements:

- · Must be a senior at a North Carolina public high school
- · Must be an SECU member or is eligible for membership through a parent/guardian
- · Must be a United States citizen, a resident of North Carolina, and eligible for in-state tuition
- Must be accepted to attend one of the 16 UNC system universities as a full-time undergraduate
- · Must have demonstrated scholastic achievement with a 2.5 or higher unweighted GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Must have demonstrated leadership, excellence of character, integrity and community involvement
- Must file FAFSA as part of the application

The State Employees Credit Union offers scholarships to students accepted to one of the 16 UNC system universities as a full-time undergraduate.




